ENEMY AIR---Two E/A painted black below formation--didn't attack. Were engaged by
Spitfires at target.RESULTS---Hits across M/Ys just south of north junction and from south choke
point north to middle of M/Ys. Some bombs started at river S. of M/Yds
and walked along tracks northward. Dust from previous attack considerably
obscured north part of M/Ys. One very large crater seen at north jct.OBSERVATIONS---20 car train standing in station on railroad between Orte and Stinigliano
Four trucks headed west from Orte.Marine---Two small and one medium M/V at San Benedetto Harbor. The vessels
were tied closely together at end of north jetty.

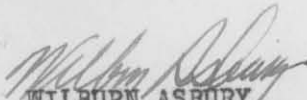
