 Target: Clouds: None. Visibility Slight haze, 15 miles.
 Return: Clouds: 6/10 stratocumulus in mountains, base at 4,000 ft, tops at 6,000 ft. Visibility: Slight haze, 15 miles.

FLAK:---Target: Slight to moderate, heavy, generally inaccurate.

ENEMY AIR: None.

RESULTS: Bombs fell in area south of town between main road and secondary road and carried #across main road southeast of the junction. Some hits reported along east edge of town and some in north part of town. One crew identified place bombed as Castel Gandolfo. Large oil fire observed southeast of Albano.
