reported on some small buildings in area and on road running N.W.

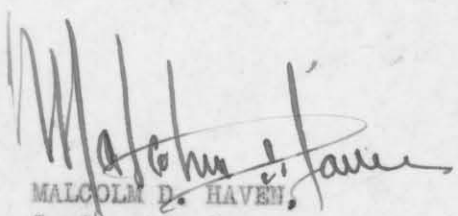

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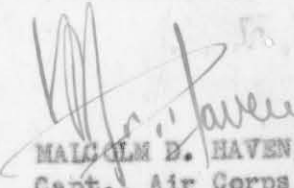
