RETURN: Clouds, from initial point back to base clear.
Visibility: Unlimited.
FLAK: Heavy, moderate, accurate from area of Ceprano.
ENEMY AIR: None. CLAIMS: None.

RESULTS: The second flight went over the target at 310 degrees as briefed
and finding overcast made a wide right turn and coming under over-
cast proceeded on correct heading to target. Recognized target
area, continued past making a left turn inside Ceprano and came
back on about a 90 degree heading at 6500 feet and bombed at 1515
west of Piedmonte, reporting some hits in target area - others on
hills just west of town.

The second box of six of the second flight after making the wide
turn broke off from the first box while going under overcast.
Making a 60 degree right turn, leveling out and bombing from 6700
feet what they considered the target area at 1514, on heading of 360°

The first flight finding target area covered by overcast returned
to base without dropping bombs.

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OBSERVATIONS: 200 trucks reported N of Pico at 1500.

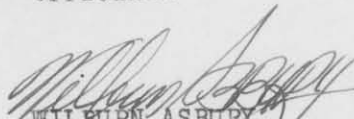
