- 0755 446th to ODO. "Have Maj. Larson call 446th in re to practice mission".
- 0855 Cameron to Controller. "Cleared local low altitude mission and local practice mission (formation, 12 planes)."
- 1115 Fitzpatrick to Hoffman. "Group Commanders meeting in Gen. Knapps office at 1130 today. Col. Smith is away--Col Remington will attend".
- 1120 446th to Asbury. "Due to lack of practice bombs, request permission to drop 100 lb. Demos on Range #3. Permission not granted, cannot drop Demos on #3. Give PDI practice instead".
- 1145 Bell to Larson. "Practice mission fouled up--did not assemble".
- 1155 Larson to Newhall 889. "Cleared plane for Bombing Range (448th)".
- 1245 Asbury to Controller. "Cleared 760 (Jordan), 123 (Vivas) for Bombing Range".
- 1300 Larson to 57th Wing. "Info on McAllister's A/C".
- 1400 Asbury to Ackerman. "Still waiting on weather Recce".
- 1420 Borgo to Asbury. "A/C on Range shows "Cockeral"--emergency AEF".
- 1430 "Target weather O.K. Rendezvous 10 miles E. Weather is "stinko". Make Sure".
- 1435 Cameron to 448th. "Set up one A/C with baggage racks for 0800 take off on 5 April, to proceed to Capodichino and pick up two men--and return".
- 1440 Ackerman to Cameron. "Check on distribution of 64th F.Wing Weather Code dated May 1, 1944".
- 1800 Tokez to Asbury. "Fuzing is Inst. and .025. Rendezvous for low level 10 minutes after first formation. Escort: 8 or 12 Spits. Peretta A/D is target. Rendezvous W of Golo River, C/S of escort is "Drybeef".
- 2020 Fitzpatrick to Hoffman. "New Target--Town N. of 310th Target".
- 2045 Swap finds with 310th. "Same Primary, different Alternate".
- Hoffman to Newhall 889. "Cleared 448th A/C to Capodichino & Foggia, A/C #s 765, 481, 195, 445".
- 2315 Blake to Upton MLO. "Have you cleared aircraft 429 for Foggia on 5 May 1944? Yes, cleared to Naples, flight time 0700 to 0930. Maj. Hunter's clearance is O.K."
