- 1012 57th Wing Flight Section to Blake. "Asked for Lt. Hoffmah. Wanted to know when we were sending 2 replacement aircraft. We will call back".
- 1030 446th E to Blake. "Asked if crew of 43-27690 (J) was in the Group. All T.O.'s and papers mission".
- 1100 Cameron to Wing. "Is it a repeat on the Target for this morning. Wing will call back and let us know as soon as possible".
- 1115 Borgo to Hoffman. "P-39's circling ditched crew".
- 1125 Fitzpatrick to Cameron. "24 on "Berlin". 24 on "160-10". No second attack on "Berlin". TOT, 1700 first. TOT, 1715 second".
- 1130 Hoffman to Fitzpatrick. "Passed on information of P-39's circling ditched crew". A/C 327, Swanson.
- 1230 Armstrong to Hoffman. "Swanson's crew safe, picked up by launch".
- 1500 Terhune to Toohey. "572 did not check out on mission preflight. Lt. Dormier in 179 will be replacement".
