26 May 1944.

Informed Medics to have Three (3) Ambulances on line by 1800 this afternoon.

1st Mission Fighter call sign is Poorman #1.

2nd Mission Fighter call sign is Poorman A.

1840 Maj. Milner (Godfrey 14) to Neumann. "Call 3rd Group if we need help to refuel incoming Transient planes".

1810 Wing to Larson. "For 27 May 1944. 96 aircraft, load is 500's except for 24 for the afternoon which will be 1000's".

Squadrons notified.

1734. Abbot to Neumann. "B-25 (Greh) crashed near Ghisonaccia".

1748 Newhall 144 to Toohy. "The plane that crashed at Ghisonaccia is endangering houses from fire. Asked if there were bombs in A/C. Maj. Larson checked the tower and was informed that Lt. Greh had dropped his bomb-load in the Sea--relayed info".

Lt. Greh is on way to hospital with broken leg.

A/C 029 landed at Bergo--crew is safe and we are to send transportation to pick them up.

From Lt. Sampson. CP from 446th or Bombardier got flak wound in shoulder. On way to hospital. A/C is carrying bombs".

2230 Fitzpatrick to Cassidy. "On directive for P.M. Missions for 27th, only 1st 24 planes refers to 321st, 2nd 24 planes to the 310th; error made in typing directive".

26 May 1944.

Cann to Griffing. "Mission for the 27th: 24 A/C with 500's, 24 A/C with 1000's. No target as yet".

Squadrons and Ordnance notified. 447 & 445 with 500's, 448 & 446 with 1000's.

Larson to Sector Controller. "Informed them that are #1 flight would probably be a little late."

Fenner to Larson. "Wanted names of Pilots and Co-Pilots to be on DS to Fighter Wings for two weeks--this is other than C-47".

Wing to FAS. "Wanted names of Pilots and Co-Pilots (1 CP, 2 P) for the 63rd and 57th F. W."

Larson to Wing. "Names of Pilots DS to Service Group: 448th, 2nd Lt. JOHN C. CONNOR, O-808789 (P); 446th, 2nd Lt. ROBERT B. HAWKINS (CP), O-752409; 445th, 2nd Lt. MICHAEL A. SANTONE (P), O-750413.

Larson to Fenner. "Squadrons Air-borne. A/C 564 seen by Fighters on single engine still flying just North of Bologna".

1500 Williamson to FAS. "Tables are completed, and we are to pick them up at one at S. S."

1615 Blake to Wing. "Asked if the names had been submitted for personnel to DS to 63rd and ~~57th~~ 57th F.Wings. The answer, yes".
